REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS



Regular Verbs

Regular verbs form their past and past participle forms by adding -ed.

- I watched TV last night.
- I played baseball this morning.
- We studied hard for this test.
- I enjoyed the new film.
- My brother **climbed** the cliff wall.
- The lamb jumped over the fence.
- They cooked an amazing meal.

Irregular Verbs

Irregular verbs do not follow the normal patterns for tense and past participle.

- We ate the pizza quickly.
- I drank some cola.
- They slept in the treehouse.
- She got a watch at Christmas.
- He swam in the ocean.
- The child dug a hole.
- The dog hid the bone in the garden.
