USES OF ORDINAL NUMBERS

DATES: Her birthday is on the **29th**.

CENTURIES: Shakespeare was born in the **16th** century.

SEQUENCE/ORDER: My team came **second** in the league.

FLOORS OF A BUILDING: His office is on the **tenth** floor.

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Personal Information

You can expect questions asking basic personal information such as:

- What is your full name?
- When is your birthday?
- Where were you born?
 - What is your race?
- Are you Hispanic or Latino?
- What is your current address?
- What is your phone number?

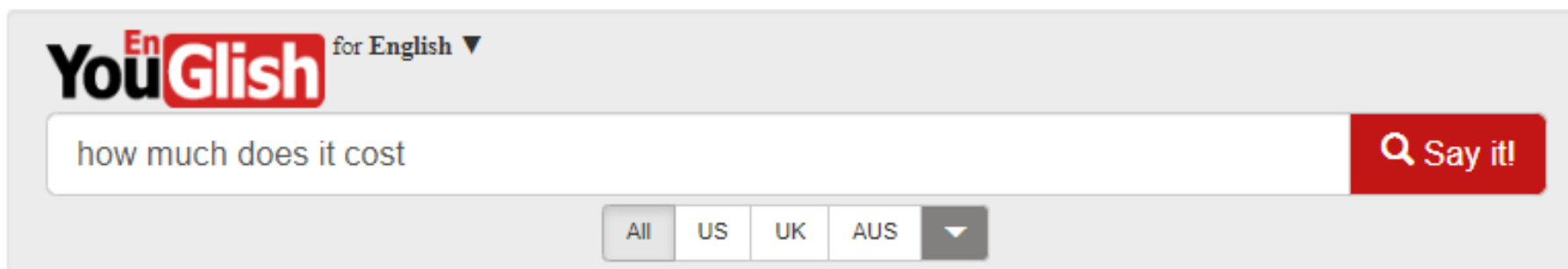

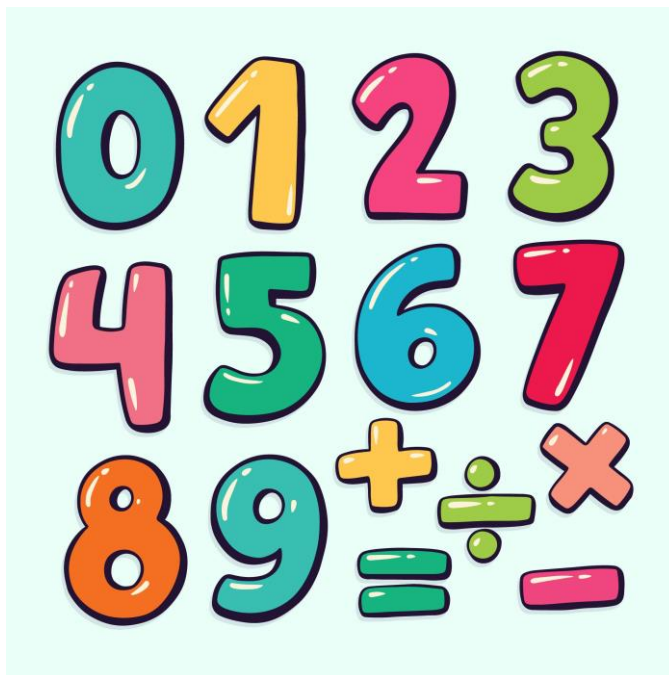
